

WIGMORE SCHOOL POLICY

2.13 Uniform (High)

All pupils are expected to wear the school uniform. We believe this helps to foster a good community feeling, reduce unwanted differences, and produce a good self-image. With parents co-operation our aim is for all pupils to look smart and have a pride in their appearance. Every effort has been made to choose garments which are widely available and reasonably priced.

ITEM/COLOUR	NOTES
Wigmore High – Navy blue , sweatshirt	Available from Clubsport in Ludlow or Leominster. No others are permitted. Sweatshirts which are too baggy or obviously too small are not permitted
Trousers - Black	Plain black school trousers– polyester - not 100% cotton, not with attached pockets, not tight fitting to the leg not flared at the bottom, no combat trousers (pockets on the legs), no jeans style (i.e. pockets on back) and no lycra trousers
Shirt – White	Regulation style not tightly fitted, long or short sleeve. Shirts must be tucked in; if a sweatshirt is worn, shirts must not be visible below the bottom of the sweatshirt
Undergarments	Should not be visible, e.g. through shirts and above trousers level
Skirt – Black school skirt	Available from Clubsport only . Girls should ensure their skirt is the correct for their height (i.e. skirts must not be too short and must be worn just above the knee or just below the knee)
School Tie	Available from school only—worn showing school logo just below knot
Shoes – Black plain	Strong and fully enclosed to protect the foot - no trainers, no walking shoes, no boots, no high-heeled shoes or no canvas pumps
Outdoor Coat	with a loop to hang in the cloakroom – no sweatshirts, hoodies or tracksuit tops
Socks – Dark plain or white (not striped or patterned)	

Dress code rules:

Hair - if hair is likely to fall over the face of a pupil during any lesson, we expect the pupil provides a means of restraining it during the school day. Hair should be a natural colour and not two-toned or striped, e.g. excessive highlights, dip dyed or extreme bleaching. No hairstyle should draw undue attention to the wearer and so distract others, e.g. spiked too high, hanging in the face, dreadlocks, untidily cut, cut too short (number 2 minimum length allowed) or an unblended undercut. No excessive use of hair gel or wax is permitted

- Jewellery should be restricted to one small plain round gold or silver stud in each ear. No other jewellery, including any other piercing, is permitted.
- Make-up and nail varnish (including gel or acrylic nails) are not allowed.
- Brightly coloured hair accessories or belts are **not acceptable**; please wear **plain** black or navy.
