

WIGMORE SCHOOL POLICY

Uniform (Primary)

All pupils are expected to wear the school uniform. We believe this helps to foster a good community feeling, reduce unwanted differences, and produce a good self-image. With parents' co-operation, our aim is for all pupils to look smart and have pride in their appearance. Every effort has been made to choose garments which are widely available and reasonably priced.

ITEM	NOTES
Wigmore Primary Navy blue sweatshirt	Available from Clubsport in Hereford. No others are permitted. Sweatshirts which are too baggy or obviously too small are not permitted
Trousers or shorts Grey	Plain grey school trousers or shorts – polyester - not 100% cotton, not with attached belts, not tight fitting to the leg, not flared at the bottom, no combat trousers (i.e. pockets on the legs), no jeans style (i.e. pockets on back) and no lycra trousers
Polo shirt White	Shirts should be tucked in to trousers/ shorts or skirt
Skirt or Pinafore Grey	Children should ensure their skirt / pinafore is the correct length for their height (i.e. skirts must not be too short and must be worn just above the knee or just below the knee)
School dress Blue check	Summer term only
Socks	Dark plain or white (no trainer socks to be worn with trousers).
Shoes Black plain	Strong and fully enclosed to protect the foot - no trainers , no walking shoes, no boots, no high-heeled shoes or no canvas pumps
Outdoor Coat	Ideally with a loop to hang in the cloakroom – no sweatshirts, hoodies or tracksuit tops

Dress code rules:

- Hair - if hair is likely to fall over the face of a pupil during any lesson, we expect the pupil provides a means of restraining it during the school day. Hair must be tied back for practical lessons. Hair should be a natural colour and not two-toned or striped, e.g. no excessive highlights, no balayage, no dip dyed or extreme bleaching is allowed. No hairstyle should draw undue attention to the wearer and so distract others, e.g. spiked too high, hanging in the face, untidily cut, too short, no excessive gel or wax. Short hair should be blended/graded gradually. No undercuts, mohawks, tramlines, mullets or similar trends allowed.
- Jewellery should be restricted to one small plain round gold or silver stud in each ear. No other jewellery, including any other piercing, is permitted.
- No make-up is allowed
- No nail varnish (including gel or acrylic nails) are allowed. If nail varnish is applied at the weekend or during holidays it must be removed prior to returning to school
- Brightly coloured hair accessories or belts **are not** acceptable, please wear plain black or navy.
